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MUD News

The MUD Board held its regular monthly meeting on December 1, 2020, at the David C. Ellis Community Center, 3303 Doe Run. All Directors were present.

The first order of business was to swear in the newly elected directors – Ron Stried, Mike Tomme, and Russell Downey. The Board voted unanimously to approve the Oaths of Office and Statements of Elected Officer for each; Ms. McCalla noted that their terms of office would expire in May 2024.

The Board then adopted a new slate of officers: Ron Stried-President, Sam Harper-Vice President, Cindy Nettles-Secretary, Mike Tomme-Treasurer, and Russell Downey-Asst. Secretary/Treasurer.

Deputy Rush updated the Board on the speed study being done by the county – a "data box" was being used to collect information from various locations to determine the best steps to take to deter speeding within the neighborhood. He also reported that package thefts were increasing during the holiday season and encouraged all to remain observant.

Mr. Evans reported that weekly meetings with City representatives continued regarding the proposed Contract for Wholesale Water and Wastewater Services. He confirmed that the final closing on the District's purchase from the City of the water and wastewater facilities was estimated to occur on March 12, 2021.

The Board discussed the proposed water and wastewater rates, but took no action.

General Managers Report - Amy Loughrey **Administration**

- The new homeowner portal has been launched.
- Assessment statements have gone out via email and the payment portal is ready.
- Most of the outstanding assessments are being handled by our attorney.
- · Year to date resales of homes total 71.
- Trash cans, yard maintenance, RV's boats and trailers continue to be the primary CCR violations.

Parks and Common Areas

- Gatling Gun The playground merry go round has been installed.
- Gatling Gun More landscape improvements are underway.
- Capistrano The basketball and tennis courts have been resurfaced. Some cracks remain in the tennis courts and are most likely due to the age of the surface.
- Doe Run The community center has several items that need work including painting and general maintenance.
- Shady Hollow West The new dog park is expecting a late December start date for construction.

Capistrano Pool

- The pool is closed for general and adult swim as of Oct. 31, 2020
- All readings and operations of the equipment are within specifications.
- There were no incidents to report.

Events

- Girl Scout Troop #44002 held a holiday parade benefiting Brown Santa.
- A drive through event with Mr. and Mrs. Santa Claus will be held at the CC on December 20th.

Treasurers Report - Geoff Lawson Bank accounts/Balance Sheet

- Our register balance in our Chase Bank operating account as of 11/30/20 was \$279,356.11. The balance was reconciled to the QuickBooks ledger by both the treasurer and the Heyman CPS firm.
- Our reserve accounts as of 11/30/20 had \$164,732.05 in our Chase Reserve Account and \$209,679.86 in our CD at TDECU. Our total reserve accounts aggregate to \$374,411.91
- Interest earned on our CD for the month ending 11/30/20 was \$363.01. On 11/30/20 we transferred \$8,083.34 from our operating account to our reserve account at Chase Bank in accordance with the funding plan detailed in our Feb 2017 reserve study.

Revenue

- On a Cash Basis presentation, total income for the month ending 11/30/20 was \$9,166.02 versus budgeted income of \$6,325.00. For the eleven months ending 11/30/20 we have received total income of \$698,883 compared to budgeted revenue of \$680,710. This is largely the result of unexpectedly high sales of homes in the association (transfer fees and resale certificates aggregate to \$31,700 versus the full year projection of \$22,500)
- For the eleven months ending 11/30/20, facility fees are now \$5,475 less than projected due to COVID.

Expenses

- Note there were \$3,175.57 in software expenses associated with account number 60510. The majority of which were a result of the switch over to NABR network (our new website)
- Legal fees for the month of November aggregated to \$6,110.90 which was higher than expected. To reiterate, budgeting for legal fees is the single most difficult number to predict. It is predicated on knowing how many people will be in collections and the extent we will have to go in order to receive what is due the Association.
- There was an expense of \$10,964.50 associated with the construction of the dog park in Shady Hollow West that was previously board approved. This payment represents ½ of the total fence contract that was accepted.

MRI Expenditures

 There was an MRI expenditure of \$5,721.23 associated with working being done within Gatling Gun Park, which was previously approved in our 2017 Reserve Study.
